Alan "Rooster" W. Zawadzki, 73, Green Bay passed away on Saturday, October 17, 2020 due to natural causes at Aurora BayCare Medical Center. Alan was born on November 8, 1946 in Milwaukee the son of the now late Walter and Phyllis (Poniewacz) Zawadzki. He served his country in the United States Navy serving two tours in Vietnam from 1965 until his honorable discharge in 1967. Alan was a River Rat, which was some of the fiercest and most dedicated US Navy sailors and served on a Patrol Boat River or commonly called a PBR by the Rats on the Mekong River, frequently encountering the enemy in fire fights. He was wounded on a trip while rescuing an abandoned baby from the shore and received the Purple Heart for his heroic actions as well The Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross from the Vietnam Government for this selfless act. Alan, was a Pastor and always had a heart for the Lord and gave his life to Christ at a young age. He had a passion for Harley Davidson motorcycles and loved riding and hanging with his friends and always had a good time. Alan was a such a kind hearted person who truly cared for the ones he loved and would do anything for them. Alan is survived by one son and daughter-in-law: Alan and Mariah Zawadzki, one daughter: Felicia "Filly" Zawadzki, two grandchildren: Amyiah and Antonio "AJ", dear friends: Deb and George Walton, a special friend: Burnes Russell. He is further survived by other relatives and friends.
