Gordon “Gordy” J. Dellise, 92, Green Bay, passed away on Friday, February 28, 2025, and was reunited in Heaven with the love of his life, Patti. Gordy lived a long and fulfilling life among family, friends and colleagues. His deep faith was an inspiration to all who knew and loved him dearly. Gordy was born on September 14, 1932, in Algoma, the son of the now late Raymond and Louise (Vandervest) Dellise. He attended Algoma High School and served his country in the United States Navy serving aboard the U.S.S. Caperton until his honorable discharge in 1955. On June 12, 1952, he married the former Patricia “Patti” Witt and the couple enjoyed almost 56 years together. Patti preceded him in death on June 8, 2008.
