Graduated from Preble High School (1970); studied Foolishness at UW-Green Bay 1970- 1971 (according to his FB profile), Bus Admin at UW-Eau Claire 1973 – 1976, Data Processing at Chippewa Valley Tech 1977-1978 and Accounting at Northeast Wisconsin Tech 2007-2010. Worked at Schreiber Foods as a computer operator for 25 years.

Greg raised fish (African Cichlids) for many years and taught his nephews Latin fish names (they still remember Juliochromis dichfildi). Raised in a musical family, he added the booming baritone voice and played trumpet.

Greg was born with a photographic memory and analytical mind. Fortunately, he recognized that his sisters were as smart as he was, but that didn't stop him from refusing to listen to our common sense (he ran short in that department, as well as social skills and patience). He had his favorite jokes, which he told repeatedly. His hearing was mostly gone for the last 30 years, which made conversations "interesting" and LOUD.

Greg was an audiophile, voracious reader, motorcycle rider, plant doctor and

vertical gardener extraordinaire.

He excelled at baking cheese cake and fruit pies and was known for his extensive vocabulary. Starting in his early years, he enjoyed rummage sales and flirting with “cute waitresses” at his favorite restaurants (including Bayview Family Restaurant).

Among items he collected are recipe (and other) books, matchbooks and vinyl record albums. Greg was a loyal, generous, funny and fun guy.

Greg never fully recovered from a hemorrhagic stroke in 2013. The next stroke in March 2023 was too much for his body to bounce back. Because he carried a signed organ donor card, 30-60 others will benefit from our loss.
