Jacqueline "Jackie" Roffers, 85, Green Bay, died on Monday, October 25, 2021 at Unity Hospice following a brief illness. Jackie was born on December 17, 1935, in Green Bay the daughter of the now late Emil and Selma (Kaminski) VanDenBusch. Jackie had a business degree and was employed at Burrough's in the Business Office before her marriage on August 31, 1957 to David S. Roffers. She was a homemaker and loving mother to her 5 children: Therese (Joseph) Hansen; Karen (Robert) Grzywa; Steven Roffers (partner, Ivan DaSilva); Don Roffers (Deceased); and Gene Roffers (spouse, Robert Colella). Jackie was always volunteering and taught her children to serve others by volunteering. She took great pride in her services as a playground monitor at her children's grade school; was a member of the core group at St. Philip's Women's Altar Society and was in charge of the decorations for all events; was treasurer Chapter 403 NARFe, and active member of NALC. After her retirement from work, Jackie volunteered at Bellin Hospital from February 24, 2005 to November 15, 2019, giving a total of 1825 hours "working" in Bellin's Gift Shop and Learning Resource Center. Jackie greatly enjoyed traveling and making trips to visit her children and grandchildren, being present for all parties and special events, going to movies and plays, reading books. She worked at many bake sales and rummage sales.
