



## Mr. James "Jim" J. Flood

January 17, 1941 - January 1, 2025

Born January 17, 1941 to James Peter and Helen MacDonald Flood. Jim grew up in Green Bay, WI, attending Cathedral Grade School and Premontre High School. He was a proud "Bucky," having graduated from the University of Wisconsin- Madison in 1965. Service to his country followed in the United States Marines. Returning home, Jim began his life-long career in Human Resources with National Can (now Ball Corporation). From plant personnel manager for National Can in Green Bay to plant start-up in Gary, Indiana, to Director of Labor and Government Compliance at Chicago headquarters, Jim negotiated plant labor contracts and was on teams which negotiated master agreements with large unions.
