Joyce Ann Holschuh (née Tlachac), was born November 24, 1935 to Richard and Alice (née Gilson), in Lincoln, Wisconsin. Joyce, her parents, and her sister Joan eventually moved to a farm of their own in the nearby Township of Forestville. Joyce attended Saint Mary's grade school and graduated from Algoma High School. Joyce received her RN degree from Holy Family school of nursing in 1956 and began commuting to Green Bay to begin her career. It was on those bus rides that she met the bus driver, Tom Holschuh, whom she married in April of 1958. They were married for 63 years until Tom's passing in 2022. They raised five children, and watched their family grow to 13 grandchildren and four great grandchildren. Joyce was a proud mother, a doting grandmother, who welcomed many a large gathering on the sunny shores of the Bay.
