Kenneth was born to Joseph F. and Mabel (Cherney) Schlies on November 28, 1936 on a dairy farm in the Township of Franklin, Kewaunee County, where he was taught to work hard and overcome discouragements and live by Christian values. Besides work at a young age, he was taught how to dance the polkas and waltz's of those years. He loved to dance!

On September 9, 1953 at his uncles (dad's brother) wedding he met the brides cousin, also a very good dancer, whose name was Pearl; who also had to milk cows at home. They continued to date until November 28, 1957; on Thanksgiving Day when they got married at Pearl's home church (St. Joseph's) in Norman in the Township of Carlton, Kewaunee County to a very crowded church. They began farming and milking cows till low milk prices forced Kenneth to find extra income and he started at Brebner Machinery a Caterpillar dealer repairing heavy equipment which he loved. In 1969 the dairy farm was sold and the whole family moved to Bellevue where they still reside today.

When Ken was in his 50's and his work kept him away for weeks at a time and his parents wanted to retire from there tire business, Pearl asked Ken to take over the tire shop so he could be home. So with the help of their two Sons Keith and Kevin they worked till Ken was 65 when their two sons took over. Kenneth is survived by his wife of 64 years, Pearl (Pelnar) Schlies and their

children: Bonnie (Lee) Spencer, Kevin (Michelle) Schlies and Danny Schlies and his special friend Martha. In addition his six Grandchildren; Shelly (Jeff) Schott, BJ (Amber) LeRoy, Joey Schlies, Jamee Schlies, and the twins Amber Schlies and Trevor Schlies.
