Matthew “Matt” “Slim” J. Ver Haag, 39, Allouez, passed away unexpectedly on, Sunday, July 21, 2019. He was a graduate of East De Pere High School with the class of 1998 and completed the DOC Correctional Officer Program in Oshkosh. He was very talented in the kitchen and was an excellent cook. His biggest passion however was gaming and was very skilled at computers. 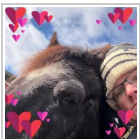
