



## Patricia Marion Gille

Patricia M. (Kernan) Gille, age 94 a Green Bay resident passed away Saturday evening, April 13th 2024 at Reflections.

She was born August 11, 1929 to the late Leo and Dorothy (Plont) Kernan. She attended St. Francis Xavier Cathedral grade school and graduated from St. Joseph's Academy with the class of 1947.
