



Timothy "Tim O" L. Organisciak

March 7, 1949 - September 11, 2025

Timothy "Tim O" Organisciak, age 76, passed away on September 11, 2025. He was born on March 7, 1949, in Tonawanda, NY, to the late Thomas and Teofila "Tillie" (Agnes) Organisciak. After highschool, Tim enlisted in the U.S. Army, where he served as an aircraft mechanic. After receiving an honorable discharge two years later, he earned a degree in Mechanical Technology and transferred to the National Guard in Cincinnati, OH, serving for five years. During that time, he began his career at Procter & Gamble as a Design Engineer. On November 21, 1970, Tim married Donna Kuster. Together they welcomed their daughter Michelle in 1975 and son Timothy ("T2") in 1979. A "temporary assignment" with Procter & Gamble brought the family to Green Bay, WI, first settling in Allouez in 1981 and then moving to Green Bay in 1983. Tim and Donna were active in their community, hosting neighborhood block party pig roasts and volunteering in their children's activities—from Girl Scouts and coaching Michelle's softball teams to Boy Scouts with Timmy. As the kids grew, Tim and Donna were always in the stands or audience, cheering on Michelle's volleyball and softball games, Tim's hockey matches, and countless band concerts and piano recitals. After retiring from Procter & Gamble in 2002, Tim and Donna purchased a cottage in St. Germain, WI. They made it their sanctuary, creating years of memories fishing, feeding the wildlife, and enjoying beautiful sunsets. Tim later took a job with Fusion Integrated Solutions where he worked with a group of fellow P&G colleagues, finally retiring in 2018. Tim lost his beloved wife Donna to ovarian cancer in

2012. He found comfort and purpose in maintaining the cottage they had purchased together for retirement. In late 2016, he met Linda Pommier, and they married on January 29, 2021, expanding his family to include Linda's children, Paul and Jared (Jessica) Carter. Together, Tim and Linda enjoyed traveling to visit friends and family, spending time at the cottage, and embraced life fully until his health began to decline. Tim will be remembered for his love of sports—from cheering on the Badgers, Packers, and Brewers to managing the family football pool and organizing activities for his cherished Procter & Gamble crew, including bowling, trap shooting, and poker nights. He also had a passion for woodworking and loved collecting items he could restore or repurpose.

Tim is survived by his wife, Linda; his children, Michelle (Darin) Driessen and Tim (Amy) Organisciak; his grandchildren, Megan and Kenzi Driessen, Emillie, Adler, and Zayden Organisciak; Linda's children, Paul Carter and Jared (Jessica) Carter; Amy's children, Brittany and Zack Hermes; his siblings, Pat (Dave) Prior, Dan (Linda) Organisciak, and Paul (Patty) Organisciak; sister-in-law Patricia Kuster; and many beloved nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Thomas and Tillie, his stepmother Katherine, and Donna's parents, Leonard and Jeanne Kuster.
